
2.1 Remove any gear, items in pockets or debris that might interfere with the placement of the JETT[™] or cause additional trauma.


Step 3: DEVICE DEPLOYMENT

- 3.1 Unroll the device in preparation for application
- 3.2 Placement of JETT[™]
 3.2.A Slide the belt with "This Side Toward Casualty" facing up under the
 - body at the lower back 3.2.B Locate the Superior Iliac Crest and Pubic Bone, which are connected by the Inguinal Ligament
 - 3.2.C Lifting the hips, position the belt under the buttocks so that the buttocks pad is centered behind the casualty and the pressure pads are immediately below (inferior to) the Inguinal Ligament




enor Crest for Pad Placement
